- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be willing and able to serve a full term and actively participate in Board meetings, committees, and required training
- Demonstrate integrity, sound judgment, and a commitment to the Credit Union's mission, members, and community
- Possess skills, experience, or expertise that contribute to effective governance (e.g., financial services, leadership, legal, accounting, risk management, or community involvement)
- Have no conflicts of interest that would impair independent judgment or violate Credit Union policies
- Meet all applicable requirements under federal and state law, including NCUA regulations
- Successfully complete any required background checks, disclosures, and onboarding/training requirements
- Be bondable by the credit union's fidelity bond company

Each director is expected to prepare for and attend regular monthly meetings and the annual membership meeting. In addition, attendance may be required at planning sessions or other related events.

Failure to adhere to the Policies and Procedures of Tidemark Federal Credit Union may result in removal from the volunteer position.

It is the intent of Tidemark Federal Credit Union to conduct background checks on all potential candidates. By signing the disclosure below, you consent to a criminal background check and authorize the Credit Union to obtain employment information, credit reports, and verification of any degree(s) or certificate(s), as applicable, in connection with this application and review process.

All positions on the Board of Directors and Supervisory Committee are volunteer positions. Credit Unions are not for profit financial cooperatives and Boards and Committees are unpaid officials.
